Dear Resident,

This is to inform you that on March 9, 2009, the Borough of Lodi enacted an ordinance pertaining to Residential Security Alarms installed in your home. This ordinance has some stipulations with regard to obtaining permits for your alarm system and the renewal of these permits on a yearly basis. The failure for someone who does not register their alarm or renew their permit with the Lodi Police Department will be subject to a fine of up to \$50.00 as stated in the Ordinance.

The permit, which is issued by the Lodi Police Department, is available at the Lodi Police Department Central Services Division, and on both the Lodi Police Department www.lodipd.org and Borough of Lodi www.lodi-nj.org websites. Currently there is no charge for an operator's permit or the renewal of an operator's permit.

Also in accordance with this ordinance, the owner will be subject to fines for false alarms coming from their residence. A 1st offense of any violation of this ordinance will be a warning, any subsequent violation will incur a fine for any false alarms thereafter.
